1. Safe Walking Routes

- a. Review school boundaries
 - i. Buses for students in the canyon, and in Springville.
Students that live in Mapleton do not have a bus.
- b. School Access Route Plan
 - i. saferoutesutahmap.com
 1. Will be put on school website
- c. Look at access routes to get to school
 - i. Look at crossings and busy roads
 1. Crosswalk on 1600 N was added earlier this year
 2. Teachers stationed at locations around school before and after (crosswalk on 1000 E, Kindergarten Loop, Flagpole, hole in fence by shed)
- d. Issues Requiring Attention
 - i. No sidewalks on both sides of 1200 N to get to the path
 - ii. Consistent sidewalk along 1600 N
 - iii. No flashing signs in front of school
 1. Speed limit is already 25 mph- has to be 30 mph or more to get the flashing lights
 - iv. Flashing lights at intersection of 1600 N and Main Street (stop signs)
 - v. Flashing stop lights at the 3-way stop at 1200 N and 400 E.
